

PARTICIPATION POINT MAKE-UP ASSIGNMENT GUIDELINES (FOR EXCUSED ABSENCES)

Excused absences include illness, outside arts, family requested- or medical leave, all other absences for which a student's parents or guardian has notified the school, and the school has approved the release.

1. Write a short response to an article about something pertaining to vocal music. The article can be from a newspaper, online music site, CityPages, etc., and should include a short summary and your reaction to the article.

OR

2. Attend a performance and write a response about what you saw and what you gained from the experience.

OR

3. Write a reflection about a recent performance you were in, responding to what you learned from the experience.

For any of these three options, you may write at least a half page per absence (handwritten or typed is fine). If typed, feel free to email directly to your teacher whose class you were absent from. To receive credit, assignments must have:

1. the student's full name,
2. date the assignment is handed in,
3. Date(s) of excused absences
4. Date, title and location of performance OR Date, title, author, source, and URL (as applicable) of article.

These make up assignments are due within **TWO WEEKS** from the date of absence. Please don't hesitate to contact any of your Vocal Arts Department teachers with further questions about making up your participation points.
