SPCPA is excited to announce that we are using a virtual platform, Edgenuity, to deliver online options for academic courses, beginning with the 2020-2021 school year. Students now have the option to take online academic class(es) in place of in-person classes and/or for credit recovery. Edgenuity's Courseware features curriculum designed and assembled by educators using an instruction model founded in the latest research. Students will engage with SPCPA teachers to complete rigorous assignments, performance tasks, and assessments to ensure subject-area mastery.

REASONS TO SIGN UP FOR AN ONLINE COURSE:

- You experience success in an online learning environment.
- You are interested in learning in an alternative environment.
- You have a schedule conflict.
- You need to recover credit for graduation.
- You have extenuating circumstances that impact school.
- You wish to take an extra academic class instead of a study hall.

AVAILABILITY

The availability of online courses will be determined by student enrollment; however, students may register for any number of the online options listed below in place of the in-person courses they would typically request at their grade-level.

STRUCTURE AND EXPECTATIONS

Students and families interested in pursuing online options should consider the following:

- Online courses will take the place of in-classroom courses, guided study halls, or senior studies on a student's schedule.
- Students may work on online coursework at home or on campus.
- Chromebooks and work space will be available at school for students who do not have a personal device.
- Students must be comfortable with learning that lacks consistent face-to-face interaction.
- Teachers will be available for in-person meetings, but students must also be able to work independently.
- Students must log in at least 3 times a week and spend at least 4-5 hours per course per week working on assignments.
- Students who do not make timely and adequate progress may be asked to transition back to the in-person class.
- Online courses require more coursework because "seat time" cannot count toward credit hours.
